

Data protection information for participation in the Sustainable Supporter Patch of Sustainable Meetings Berlin

Thank you for signing up for the Supporter Patch

We will notify internal parties involved in the rendering of the respective processes, e.g., the Communications Department and the Berlin Convention Office, of the contact information required for your participation. Your personal information will be processed for purposes of use of the Supporter Patch and used, among other things, for internal documentation, communication on convention.visitBerlin.de, and in the social media channels Twitter: [@BerlinMeetings](https://twitter.com/BerlinMeetings) and LinkedIn: Berlin Convention Office (our hashtags: [#conventionofficeberlin](https://twitter.com/conventionofficeberlin) and [#sustainablemeetingsberlin](https://twitter.com/sustainablemeetingsberlin)).

As per Art. 6 para. 1 a)-c) GDPR, we are authorised to retrieve, store, and forward personal information if the data subject has consented to the data processing, or if a contract or legal obligation must be fulfilled.

Your rights as the data subject:

- as per Art. 15 GDPR, to request disclosure of your personal information that we process. In particular, you can request disclosure of the processing purposes, category of personal information, categories of recipients to whom your data have been or are disclosed, the planned storage period, the existence of a right to correction, deletion, limitation of processing, or objection, the existence of a right to file a complaint, the origin of your data if we did not retrieve them, and the existence of an automated decision-making process including profiling, and any pertinent information on the details thereof;
- as per Art. 16 GDPR, to request the immediate correction of incorrect or completion of incomplete personal information that we store;
- as per Art. 17 GDPR, to request the deletion of your personal information that we store, provided the processing is not required to exercise the right to freedom of expression and information, to fulfil an obligation, for reasons of public interest, or to assert, exercise, or defend legal claims;

- as per Art. 18 GDPR, to request the limitation of the processing of your personal information, provided you contest the accuracy of the information, the processing is illegal but you reject the deletion thereof and we no longer require the information, yet you require it to assert, exercise, or defend legal claims, or you have objected to the processing as per Art. 21 GDPR;
- as per Art. 20 GDPR, to request your personal information provided to us in a structured, conventional, and machine-readable format, or to request forwarding thereof to another responsible party;
- as per Art. 7 para. 3 GDPR, to revoke your consent granted to us at any time. This results in us no longer being allowed to perform the data processing based on the previously granted consent; and
- as per Art. 77 GDPR, to file a complaint with a supervisory authority. You can find the contact information for our respective supervisory authority below.
